Councilperson Griswold stated Wayne Evenson showed 160 but his was 229. Councilperson Griswold stated her showed as 240 but it was 340. Councilperson Griswold stated Lincoln's was way different because it was 177 but was 245. Councilperson Griswold stated the total off the internet was 980 compared to 693.


