    - A) Review, discussion, and possible acceptance of Police Chief Dennis Fobes's resignation effective February 14, 2020.
      - Lauren Landa, Carlin City Attorney, stated we do not have a Waiver pursuant to NRS 241 and Chief Fobes was not served with the Notice due to the time constraint preceding his resignation letter, so there should be no discussion of his Character, Misconduct, Competence or Mental Health in regards to this agenda item it should be limited to this agenda item.
      - Mayor Dana Holbrook stated he had received a letter which he read into the record;

I, Dennis Fobes, am formally resigning as the City of Carlin Police Chief. My last day will be February 14, 2020. It has been a pleasure to work for

the City of Carlin and I will miss keeping the community we live in safe.

**Motion;**

**Vice Mayor Lincoln Litchfield made a motion to accept the Police Chief Dennis Fobes’ resignation effective February 14, 2020. Councilperson Margaret Johnston seconded the motion. Motion Passed.**

B) Discussion, review, and/or possible direction to staff regarding, and/or possible approval of a mutual aid agreement and/or interlocal agreement with Elko County Sheriff’s Department, to serve in administrative, supervisory, and/or training capacities over the existing Police Department personnel and staff on an interim basis.

- Madison Mahon, Carlin City Manager, stated this afternoon the Elko County Commissioners met at 1:30 and Elko County moved to allow the DA’s Office and Lauren Landa, Carlin City Attorney, to work together on an interlocal agreement to provide supervisory support to the Police Department here in Carlin for a term of six (6) months. That would allow Lt. McKinny to come in as a supervisory position above our existing Police Officers to provide support and guidance to the department.

**Vice Mayor Lincoln Litchfield made a motion to approve directing staff with DA’s Office, and our City Attorney, Lauren Landa, to develop a mutual aid agreement and/or interlocal agreement with Elko County Sheriff’s Department to serve in an administrative, supervisory, and/or training capacities over the existing Carlin Police Department personnel and staff on an interim basis with Lt. McKinny working in an supervisory position for a maximum of six (6) months under NRS. 277. Councilperson Margaret Johnston seconded the motion. Motion Passed.**


